WHAT'S THE VALUE OF A BACHELOR'S DEGREE?

Nationally, bachelor's degree holders earn a median of about \$612 more per week than those with only a high school diploma, roughly \$31,800 more per year.* Over a career, that difference compounds into real, lasting financial security for you and your family.

A bachelor's degree opens doors that stay closed without one. Many roles, and nearly every path into management or advancement, list a four-year degree as a baseline requirement. Earning yours widens the range of careers available to you now and later.

From your very first class to your last, complete your bachelor's degree entirely online. No relocating. No commuting. Start as a freshman and finish all 120 credits on your schedule.

WHAT IT TAKES TO BEGIN

Starting is simpler than you'd think. All you need is a high school diploma or GED, a computer and a reliable internet connection. If you've already earned credit through SCOPE dual enrollment, it can count toward your bachelor's and shorten your path, but it is not required to start.

FINISH IN AS LITTLE AS 36 MONTHS

A full bachelor's degree is 120 credits. Through SCOPE, you can complete yours in as little as 36 months, a real and reachable timeline for a four-year degree.

GROUNDING IN A BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW

Every course is taught from Scripture, so you're not just earning a degree, you're building on a foundation that shapes how you lead, serve and work.

CHOOSE YOUR START-TO-FINISH DEGREE

COMMON QUESTIONS ABOUT A BACHELOR'S DEGREE

WHAT MAKES THIS DIFFERENT FROM DEGREE COMPLETION?

Our start-to-finish programs let you earn a full bachelor's degree online from the beginning, whether you're starting fresh or bringing in some credits. Degree completion is designed for students who already have significant college credit and want to finish. If you're not sure which fits, a Pathway Partner can help you map it out.

HOW AFFORDABLE IS IT, AND IS FINANCIAL AID AVAILABLE?

Tuition is \$460 per credit hour, among the more affordable rates for an accredited Christian bachelor's degree. Federal grants and loans are available for those who qualify. South Carolina residents enrolled full-time may also qualify for the SC Tuition Grant. Your Pathway Partner and BJU's Financial Aid office can walk you through your options.

DO SCOPE DUAL ENROLLMENT OR ASSOCIATE CREDITS COUNT TOWARD THIS DEGREE?

Yes. If you earned credit through SCOPE dual enrollment or a SCOPE associate degree, that credit can apply toward your start-to-finish bachelor's, giving you a head start on the same path. This is different from degree completion, which is built for students who already have significant college credit from elsewhere and simply want to finish. If a student has completed an associate degree, they would be a better candidate for degree completion. A Pathway Partner can confirm exactly where your credits land.

ARE THESE DEGREES ACCREDITED?

Yes. Bob Jones University is accredited by The Commission on Colleges and Universities (formerly known as the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges) to award associate, bachelor's and master's degrees.

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE, AND HOW FLEXIBLE IS THE SCHEDULE?

You can complete your degree in as little as 36 months, and courses are delivered online to fit around work, family and ministry. If life shifts, your Pathway Partner helps you adjust your pace.

WHAT SUPPORT WILL I RECEIVE AS A STUDENT?

You'll have a dedicated Pathway Partner who walks with you from application to graduation. They'll help you plan your schedule, navigate financial aid and stay on track to complete your degree successfully.
