WHY DUAL ENROLLMENT?

LEAP AHEAD

Working ahead can shave off a semester or even a whole year of college, saving you valuable time and making college a whole lot more affordable. Every credit you earn now is one less you'll pay full price for later — and one less standing between you and your degree.

COUNTED TWICE

For juniors and seniors, taking online college courses can count toward your school's graduation requirements while you earn college credit that you can apply to your first year of college. One class. Two boxes checked.

TRANSFER CREDITS

Credits work toward BJU Core classes and are widely transferable, as BJU is regionally accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC). Whether you continue at BJU or head somewhere else, the credits you earn through SCOPE are recognized and portable.

100% ONLINE

SCOPE's courses are 100% online and available at your own pace with 24/7 availability. Take one course or multiple at a time, with up to six start dates per year to pace your course load. Assignments, tests, and quizzes are due by 11:59 PM ET each Saturday. No required login times, no commute.

Dual enrollment helps you explore potential majors, strengthen academic and study skills, and experience the challenge of college-level coursework. It's a great way to prepare for college success, and figure out what you actually want to study before you commit to a major.

Full Semester (8–10 hrs/week) for a manageable pace alongside your high school schedule; 7.5-Week Condensed (15–20 hrs/week) when you want to move faster or use your summer.

SPEND LESS MONEY GETTING YOUR DEGREE

BJU SCOPE offers a 50% tuition discount for high school students taking college courses online, so that you can pursue an affordable college degree without worrying about debt. That's \$230 per credit — \$690 for a 3-credit class. Take a few courses before graduation and you could save your family more than \$2,000 compared to paying full freshman-year tuition for the same classes.

The discount is available following completion of your sophomore year and extends through the summer after graduation. There's no application fee; you only pay when you register.

Placement note: For 100-level English or Math, students should submit ACT/SAT scores to the Registrar or complete a free BJU placement test.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I know if I'm eligible?

Eligibility is available starting the summer following the completion of sophomore year and extends through the summer after high school graduation. To confirm your eligibility, contact your school administrator or superintendent; they can guide you through the process.

How affordable are SCOPE dual enrollment courses?

Affordability is central to SCOPE's mission. Dual enrollment courses are offered at a 50% discount — \$230 per credit, \$690 per 3-credit class — allowing families to invest in quality Christian education without the high cost of traditional college tuition.

Can I start working on my college requirements early?

Yes. Through SCOPE, you can begin completing BJU Core classes. These foundational courses build biblical thinking, effective communication, and critical reasoning skills before you ever set foot on campus.

Who teaches the courses?

Each course is developed and taught by experienced Bob Jones University faculty who integrate Scripture into every subject. Courses are designed to encourage both academic excellence and spiritual growth.

How can dual enrollment benefit me as a high school student?

Dual enrollment helps you explore potential majors, strengthen your study skills, and experience the challenge of college-level coursework. It's a proven way to prepare for college success and lighten your load before you ever graduate.

Is there a registration timeline?

Register as early as three months before a course start date. Registration must be completed no later than three days before the course begins. Don't wait too long; spots fill up.

How are these courses accredited?

Bob Jones University is accredited by SACSCOC (Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges) to award associate, bachelor's, and master's degrees. This means your credits are recognized and widely transferable to other institutions.

Will my credits transfer to other colleges or universities?

SCOPE credits are earned through SACSCOC-accredited BJU and are widely recognized. Transferability varies by institution, so we recommend checking with your target school's admissions office to confirm how credits will apply.

Is dual enrollment available to homeschool students?

Yes. Eligibility is based on academic progress, not the type of school you attend. Homeschool students who have completed their sophomore year are welcome to enroll. Contact a Pathway Partner for details.

Can I take more than one course at a time?

Yes. Many students take two courses per semester. We recommend starting with one to get a feel for the pace — especially in the 7.5-Week Condensed format — before adding more.

What technology do I need?

A reliable internet connection and a computer. SCOPE courses run through Canvas, an online learning management system accessible from any modern browser. No special software is required.

Students who begin early often discover that the greatest benefit isn't simply saving money. It's arriving prepared academically, growing in confidence, and building a stronger biblical foundation for whatever God calls them to do next.

The goal isn't to finish high school faster. **It's to begin college stronger.**
